## Size Guide

### How To Choose Your Ring Size

#### A) By Measuring With Tailor's Tape

1. Wind tailor's tape or a ribbon around the base of your finger;
2. Make a note of the circumference of your finger in millimetres or, using a pen, mark the point where the end of the tape reaches and measure the length;
3. Choose the size closest to the ones shown in the table below.

#### Tips

- The measurement of your finger may vary depending on the time of day and temperature. Measure it several times on the same day, and also on different days, so that you can compare the measurements.

## B) Measurement Using A Ring

You can measure the internal circumference of a ring that you wear already, or print out the size chart below and rest the ring on the circles to calculate the size.

### Tips

- The measurement of the ring may vary slightly according to the style. We recommend you choose one size smaller for thin rings and one size bigger for wide-band rings.
- Print out the size chart on an A4 page. Before printing, check that the image resolution is 100% for the page and that “none” is checked for page format options.
- Find your size from those shown in the above table.
